X. HOSPITAL.

The Kingston General Hospital may be attended by Students during their whole period of study by one payment of \$4 at the commencement of the course.

The Hospital has accommodation for 150 beds. The recently erected "Watkins Wing" contains a very large and commodious Clinical Lecture Room and Operating Theatre.

The Lectures on Clinical Medicine by Professor H. YATES, and Clinical Surgery by Professor MACLEAN, will in future be delivered twice a week in the new Theatre of the Hospital. Fee, entitling to attendance on both courses, \$6.
