The minister of railways is to be empowered, with the approval of the governor-in-council, to carry out any such agreement, lease or purchase.

The branch line in question was built by the Grand Trunk Pacific in order to give the road connection between Fort William and the main line of the N. E. R. at Lake Superior Junction. If the company is not to take over the operation of the N. E. R., then, of course, the government in operating the road will require also the company's present branch line to Fort William, thus giving the outlet to the lake port, for the grain moving season.
