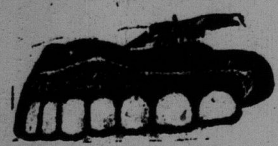

Quebec, June 15.—One of the buildings of the munition works, which was situated on the Plains of Abraham and utilized by the Dominion arsenal at about half a million rounds of small arm ammunition which had been rejected by government inspectors, either on account of being slightly overproof, or because of low velocity. There was no fulminate stored in the building at the time, and there was no loss of life, while there was only the one building damaged.
