The above letter is anonymous, but it was written, I am quite sure, by a French gentleman named Dietrich, who visited Acadie in 1710.



BILL ABOUT FOREST FIRES

Stringent Provisions in Measure in Quebec.

Fines as High as \$2,500—The Onus of Proof will be on Owner or Occupant of the Land on Which Fire is Started.

Quebec, March 14—Important amendments to the law respecting woods and forests are contained in a bill introduced by Hon. Honore Mercier, minister of lands and forests, and given second reading in the House.

It is also decreed that no person shall establish a sawmill on Crown lands and without the written authorization of the department of lands and forests, and every person who so authorizes shall comply with the regulations of the department respecting the manner of disposing of the waste from the sawmill.
