Halifax, N. S., April 6—In the House of Assembly yesterday a bill introduced by Joseph Steel, (Labor member for Cape Breton) asking that a commission be appointed to inquire into the necessity of old pensions, health and unemployment insurance, was given the three months hoist. The House expressed sympathy with the principles of the bill, but confined such principles as matters for federal consideration.

A bill introduced by Mr. Way (Labor, Cape Breton) for an amendment to the Coal Mines Regulation Act, came upfor second reading, but the speaker ruled that several sections constitued a charge upon the public revenue, and unless the member introducing it had the sanction of the crown it was out of order. It was given the three months hoist.


