long blouse in the regular way. Belt and necktie are of dark silk.


About 3 yards of 44-inch material will make the dress for a girl of 8 or 10 years. Three-quarters yard of silk and 1½ yards of 27-inch lining will also be needed.

The lining requires but a few min-

utes to make, as it requires only the closing of the underarm seam and emming of the front.

Tuck the front and stitch about an inch from the folded edge, then turn hem in right front on large "O" perforations, which also indicate center-front. After gathering the upper and lower edges of the front few the yoke to the upper edge, then try on the dress. Alterations should not be necessary, but if any little change is made do it at this point. After closing the under-arm seams, finish the sleeve, adding cuff. Arrange on the lining, being careful to make the centers even, then stitch the lower edges together. Now sew the cowboy collar to the neck edge, tack to position, bringing correspond-ing small "o" perforations in outer back and in collar together.

The skirt is laid in pleats, according to perforations and attached to the long blouse. The sash and buttons are then added, sash being finished with a large flat bow. While it is a little detail, care should be used in making the bow for the sash and the one for the neck. They should be different to avoid regu-


