That a Canadian built vessel was the first to negotiate the Atlantic ocean eatirely under steam, is the contention made in a Nova Scotta paper. It states that the Royal William, 1,000 tons and 180 horse-power, made the trip in fourteen days from Picton, N. S., to Cowss, iste of Wight, in 1833. This was five years before the voyage of the Sirius, which is generally supposed to have been the first vessel to cross the Atlantic entirely under steam. The Royal William was built at Three Rivers and her engines were installed at Montreal.
