COMMISSIONS-REPORT ON.

On motion, it was agreed that the Report on the Roll be Report rereceived, and that all matters 'relating to Commissions to this ceived—seat Assembly be referred to a Committee, to be hereafter appointed.

MODERATOR ELECTED.

Mr. John Scott and Mr. Thomas MacPherson alone remaining on the list, a vote was taken, when Mr. Scott was elected by a majority; and the yeas and nays being taken, the election of Mr. Scott was made unanimous.

Mr. Scott then took the Chair and briefly addressed the Moderator Assembly.
