C H A P. I. An O R D I N A N C E

For continuing an Ordinance made the twenty-fifth day of February, in the seventeenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Ordinance to regulate the proceedings in the Courts of Civil Judicature in the Province of Quebec."

EIT ENACTED and ORDAINED by His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and confent of the Legislative Council of the Province of Quebec, and by the Authority of the same IT is HEREBY ENACTED,

That an Ordinance made in the seventeenth year of His present Majesty's Reign, Intituled, "An

Ordinance to regulate the proceedings in the Courts of Civil Judicature in the Province of Quebec; And every Article and Clause therein contained, shall be and continue, and the same is hereby continued, to be in force from the expiration thereof and until the thirtieth day of April, which will be in the year of our Lord One thousand, seven hundred and eighty-one.

FRED: HALDIMAND.

Ordained and Enacted by the Authority aforefaid, and passed in Council, under the Great Seal of the Province, at the Council Chamber, in the Casse of St. Lewis, in the City of Quebec, the sixteenth day of January, in the nineteenth year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord GEORGE the Third, by the Grace of God, of Great-Britain, France and Ireland, King, Defender of the Faith, and so sorth, and in the year of our Lord One thousand, seven hundred and seventy-nine.
