An Act further to secure the Independence of Parliament.

FOR further securing the freedom and Independence of Parliament; Preamble. Her Majesty by &c., enacts as follows:

I. Any person who shall directly or indirectly, himself or by any person Contractors intrust for him or for his use or benefit or on his account, undertake, exe- with Govern-5 cute, hold or enjoy, in the whole or part, any contract or agreement, made ment not to be or entered into with the Crown, or with any department or officer of the Government for or on account of the public service, shall be incapable of being elected, or of sitting or voting as a Member of the Legislative Assembly during the time that he shall execute, hold, or enjoy any such 10 contract or agreement, or any part or share thereof, or any benefit or emolument arising therefrom.

II. If any Member of the Legislative Assembly shall accept from the Acceptance of Crown any office or employment of profit or emolument of a temporary temporary lunature, not paid by any annual or stated salary, his election shall be and is crative office to vacate seat. is hereby declared to be void, and a new writ shall issue for a new election, as if such person so accepting were naturally dead: Provided nevertheless, Member may that such person shall be capable of being again elected, as if his seat had be re-elected. not become vacant as aforesaid.

IV. Nothing in this Act shall repeal any Act or part of any Act now in Certain Acts force for securing the Independence of the Legislative Assembly.
