treal after a previous visitation, examination and estimation of the premises shall have been made by Experts to be named by the parties respectively, and in default of such nomina-5 tion by them, or either of them, then by the said Court, in manner and form prescribed by law; and the said Court is hereby authorized and empowered to hear, settle and finally determine the amount of such com-10 pensation in consequence; Provided always, Provisc. that the said Alexander Maurice Delisle, Benjamin Henri Lemoine, and Jean Baptiste Debien, their heirs, executors, curators and assigns, shall not commence the erec-15 tion of the said Bridge and other works by which any person may be deprived of his land or part thereof, or may suffer damage, before the price or value of the said land and damages, estimated and settled in 20 manner before prescribed, shall have been paid to such person, or such price or value shall have been offered to him, and that on his refusal thereof the said Alexander Maurice Delisle, Benjamin Henri Lemoine, 25 and Jean Baptiste Debien, shall have deposited it at the office of the Prothonotary of the Court of Queen's Bench for the said District of Montreal.

III. And whereas it may be necessary for Provision with 30 the purpose of effecting a communication changing the with the said Bridge, to change the direction of the Queen's
