MEMORANDUM FOR MR. LAPOINTE:

The Prime Minister directed me to ask you to have Council consider whether mention should be made, on the Orders of the Day, of the statement issued by the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation, as a result of their dealings with George McCullagh. The Prime Minister was at first inclined to think that the matter should be mentioned in the House, first thing, and a statement made, particularly to the effect that the government was not aware of the action of the Corporation. However, in view of Major Murray's statement appearing in this morning's paper, he is now of the opinion that no reference is necessary and that if the matter were to be brought up in the House, it would simply magnify the situation.
