



Sir-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 17th Instant, enclosing an agreement for lease between Mitchel Delisle and Pierre Livernois, whereby the former leases to the latter a portion of his property on the Caughnawaga Indian Reserve, together with certain buildings erected thereon, for a term of one year from date hereof for the sum of \$100.00, and in reply would say that, as the term is for one year, only, the Department does not deem it necessary to issue a Lease but approves the agreement forwarded and upon receipt of the sum agreed, upon, being the first quarterly payment of rental, the same will be accepted and entered.
