Kenobos Island was purchased by Frank Haight, 19th of May 1890.

Island 87 (Long Point) and 87-A, was purchased by Wm. Fryer, 31st May 1906. 87-B, 87-C and 87-D not sold.

Island 88 of Aberdeen sold to Nancy Ann Rae, 22nd September, 1904. Island 88 was purchased by Cornelius J. Swartman, 20th May, 1903.

Maxwell Island, Lot A, sold to Joseph Hughes Webb and Lot B, sold to Helen Webb, May 19th 1890.

Island 137 of Ava, not sold.

Wabena Point purchased by Jas. H. Armitage, and Manito Point by William H. Siddell, on the 19th May, 1890. The remainder of Island No. 138, not sold.

Islands, 79, 80 and 81, not sold.
