only by making an inspection of the Agencies can you form a correct impression of Mr Graham's work, and you should endeavour to do so at an early date.

Mr Graham's attention was drawn to the fact that he did not inspect the Touchwood Hills Agency last summer, and he furnished an explanation to the Department in the matter. He is now under special instructions to visit that Agency and report.

While giving due consideration to the suggestion that Mr Chisholm supercede Mr Graham and that Mr Graham be Blaced in charge of the North Saskatchewan Inspectorate, I beg to say that the case as presented does not make it blear that a transfer is altogether desirable.
