Re: George Nelson, Dinsmore, Sask., Violation of Air Regulations.

The Department wishes to prosecute Mr. George Nelson of Dinsmore, Sask., for violation of The Air Regulations, 1938.

On December 10th, 1946, Mr. Nelson acted as pilot of Aircraft CF-EEN without holding a pilot's licence in violation of paragraph 1 of Part IV of the said Regulations. Mr. Nelson was using the aircraft on the said date for the purpose of hunting coyotes for pleasure and an accident occurred about twenty miles south-east of Dinsmore. Subsequently, it is reported that Mr. Nelson flew said aircraft in an unairworthy condition and further charges may be considered by Counsel.

The Department requests the appointment of legal counsel to conduct the prosecution and it is suggested that your legal agent might communicate with Mr. R.L. Bolduc, Assistant Inspector, Air Regulations, 402 Blowey-Henry Building, Edmonton, Alberta, who will furnish him with all details.

I enclose copy of The Air Regulations for the information of your legal agent.

You might advise me of the name of the legal agent appointed in the matter.
