7th.—Standing committees shall be appoint ed annually by the Board from its own members, whose decisions, however, shall not be considered final until confirmed by the Board.

8th.—Should any member of the Board be absent from three regular Board meetings consecutively without satisfactory reasons, his seat may be declared vacant.

9th.—Vacancies occurring on the Board from death, resignation or otherwise shall be filled by the Board.

10th.—No member of the Board shall receive any remuneration for his services.

ARTICLE VIII.—DUTIES OF OFFI-CERS AND DIRECTORS.

Ist.—It shall be the duty of the President to preside at all meetings of the Association and of the Board of Management; he shall be a member, ex-officio, of all committees, and shall have a general oversight of all the affairs of the Association. In the absence of the President, the Vice-President shall perform his duties. In the absence of the President and Vice-President, the meeting shall have power to organize and appoint a Chairman to tem.

2nd.—It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to see that all fonds are promptly deposited with the bankers of the Association, and that
