AN ACT FOR THE INCORPORATION  
OF  
JEFFERY HALE'S HOSPITAL  
OF THE  
CITY OF QUEBEC.

ASSENTED TO 18TH SEPTEMBER, 1865.

W HEREAS the late Jeffery Hale, Esquire, Preamble.  
who hath recently departed this life, did,  
by his last Will and Testament, bequeath to  
Christian Wurtele, of Quebec, real and personal  
property amounting in value to nine thousand  
pounds or thereabouts, in trust and upon the  
condition that he should and would realize and  
dispose of the same to the best advantage, and  
apply the proceeds thereof to the establishment,  
at Quebec, of a Protestant Hospital, for the relief  
and cure of sick and infirm persons professing the  
Protestant religion, without regard to sect or  
denomination, the same to be for ever under  
Protestant control and direction; and whereas,  
in his said Will, he suggested that an Act of  
Incorporation should be obtained by the said  
Christian Wurtele, the Reverend David Marsh,  
and Doctor John Racey, in order to secure the  
permanency of the said Hospital; and whereas  
the said Christian Wurtele, the Reverend David
