

ARRIVAL OF THE "ACADIA."

New-York, August 14, 11 A.M.
The Acadia arrived at Boston at half-past three o'clock on Sunday. She left Liverpool on the 25th inst.

The troops are pouring into Ireland. It is supposed that there are thirty thousand troops in the two main provinces, and 100,000 Constabularies. The British Corps numbered 2,500 returned officers for South Africa, and 2,300 for Mesopotamia, Dillan, and Doherty.

The Lord-Lieutenant has issued a Proclamation suppressing Clubs. Clubs are still being organized. All the parties to the Nation arrested. The time of the new is that the Government has been temporarily arrested.

The most serious perils at last passed. FRANCE'S political situation is not confirmed. No fighting has occurred.

AUSTRIA quiet. The Diet is soon to open. The King will return.

Northern ITALY will soon be quiet. Charles Albert is inactive. The King of Naples threatens to invade Sicily. We have intelligence from Palermo stating that four of the Legislature have declared against the Pope, and some for joining Turkey, and others were disposed to go over to the Emperor.

Accounts from Madrid state that the Queen is better. A party of Spanish Liberals, who rebelled against the late officers of Valladolid, and proceeded to go to Montevideo. Monte Melu's movement is unsuccessful. The Queen is convalescing.

PORTUGAL—Nothing of note. Letter prevails in India.

Letters from the Continent speak favorably of the crops, and that the potato disease was not extensive.

No outbreak in Ireland on Friday, July 27. The West and North are comparatively free from the contagion, though for very different reasons. The accounts which we received from the County of Kerry, where the disease is most prevalent, are as follows:—The people in the North and Midland Counties of Ireland the case is different.
