the advice and consent of the Legislative Conseil and Assembly of the Province of Upper Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parlia neut of Great Britain, entitled, "An Act to repeal certain pasts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled a AntAct for making more effected provision for the Province of Quebec in North America, and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province" and by the authority of the same. That the line run by the said Lewis Grant Deputy Surveyor as aforesaid, shall be deemed and taken to be the original and true bound my between the said Concessions, any thing in any Law or this Province to the contrary notwithstanding.

Line run by Lewis Grant to be taken as the one born dark line be ween 't and de Cons. of Osnaoruck.

CHAP. XV.

An Act to establish a Market in the Town of Porth in the County of Carleton.

Preamble.

[Passed 17th January 1822.]

HEREAS it is expedient for the convenience of the Inhabitants of the County of Carleton that a Market should be established at Perth in the said County, Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Upper Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of the Britain, entitled "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled "An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North America, and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province" and by the authority of the same. That from and after the passing of this Act, a Market shall be established and kept in the town of Perch in the County aforesaid

Market established in Perth.

Justices of the Peace residing in Drammond at a Special Sessions to be by them held for that purpose to fix upon a place and make regulations for holding the said Market.

Comm'rs may imnose fives not exceeding 20s, for offences against such regulations. II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid. That it shall and may be lawful for the Commissioners of the Peace residing in the Township of Drummond at a Court of Special Sessions to be by them held for that purpose, and they are hereby authorised and empowered to fix upon a place and appoint such days and hours for the purpose of selling Butchers Meat. Butter, Eggs, Poultry, Fish, and Vegetables, and to make such other orders and regulations relative thereto as they shall deem expedient.

III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid. That the said Commissioners shall be and they are hereby authorised and empowered to impose such fine, not exceeding twenty shillings for any offence committed against such rules and regulations as to them in their discretion shall seem requisites and proper.
