CHILDREN FOR CANADA.

English Social Reformer Advocates Child Colonies in the Dominion.

Mrs. Ellinor C. L. Close, the well-known English social reformer, in a letter recently published in The London Daily Mirror, deprecates the expense and unpractical methods of rearing poor children in English institutions, and continues:

"Now, as a substitute for this costly and unpractical upbringing, I suggested that a number of small farms should be bought in the Maritime or eastern provinces of Canada, where, at least in one-third of the above-mentioned capital cost, we can obtain comfortable, old-established dairy farms, within easy reach of railways, schools, and shops. There are many for sale, owing to the young people going west, where the country is unimproved for children such as we have to deal with."

Children Now Vigorous.

"As an object lesson I bought a farm 15 miles from St. John, the capital of New Brunswick. It is in charge of two English ladies, Miss Dunlop and Miss Row, and of my own Canadian farmer and his wife, and is overlooked by a committee of local ladies and gentlemen.

"There the thirteen weakly, anemic, stunted children whom I took out last year have become vigorous, healthy, and happy, and are intensely proud of their home, and working keenly on the farm or in the house, just as all the neighboring farmers' children do, with whom they associate and attend the excellent village school on terms of perfect equality, which covers 180 acres of land, all farm stock, etc., works out at £76 per child, on a basis of twenty children, for which the farm is adapted. This shows an economy of about £200 per child, or £4,000 per group of twenty children, which is the largest number ever put on one farm.

"At one-third English cost. The maintenance of the children works out at £23 per head for the first year, but this has naturally been somewhat expensive, owing to our inexperience and to the fact that they had been fully stocked until October.

"In England maintenance varies from £30 to £47 at Chorlton, in Lancashire, and an average of some 30, 000 children is £33 9s. per head per annum, therefore here again my scheme shows a great economy, which those who have the custody of children will do well to bear in mind.

"The journey of a child from London to my farm costs £2 12s. 6d., which includes food throughout. As I write I have before me the details of the expenses incurred in sending one child from a London workhouse to a cottage in Surrey last year. They amount to £3 4s. 9d., which seems to be not by any means an unusual sum.

"To sum up, we have on our side children, health, vigor of the body and of domestic life and duties, worked upon by officials day and night at enormous expense. On the other side we have children leading a free country life, in perfect environment, learning agriculture and all domestic work, among the kindest people in the world, at one-third English cost.

"Can there be any doubt as to which system is the better for our national welfare?"
