POULTRY RULES

A great source of contagion is in the drinking troughs.

Remember, if soup should make its appearance in your poultry house, in place of "tonics" drop a nail into the drinking trough and allow it to remain there. It will supply a "structure of iron" required.

If you feed whole corn place it in the oven and parch it occasionally and feed soaking hot. The fowls appreciate it in frosty weather.

A little linseed or oil meal given once a week in the soft feed will promote laying. This will not come under the heading of "dosing the fowls with medicine."

Do not throw your table scraps in the swill barrel, but give them to the chickens.

One of the most important points in the keeping of ducks is to give them clean, dry quarters at night. They are very prone to leg weakness in cold, damp quarters.

Feed your fowls just what they will eat up clean.

Fat hens or pullets are not good layers. The latter is just what you want when the eggs are 23 cents or more per dozen.

Fowls over three years old are not as a rule good breeders. The male are unable to properly fertilize the eggs for hatching when the stock is usually weak. Four years is general a ripe old age for a fowl.

Each hen if properly kept will lay from 200 to 250 eggs a year.

Liver and intestines are an excellent food to make hens lay.

Keep an abundant supply of lime where the hens can easily get it. You desire your hens to lay well. Always clean the nest wall and put in fresh straw before the hens begin to sit.—H. J. K.

OUR WORST FOE

Dr. Hewitt Says the Fly Must be Exterminated

Dr. C. Gordon Hewitt, Dominion Entomologist in an interview at Ottawa regarding flies which he is fighting as a pest, says:—

"The fly should be regarded as a winged carrier of disease and decay; without doubt the most dangerous pest on the farm. Wherever there is filth, suppurating or purulent discharge, flies are invariably attracted, and as they are cosmopolitan in their habits and are potential disseminators of such bacteria as are contained in any contamination. It is not a question of eradication in the case of this insect, such is impossible. Control and prevention, however, are within the bounds of possibility, and these will be regarded as essential when the facts are more generally realized."

"Do you believe all flies carry germs? Need a person regard every fly with distrust?"

"No house fly can be caught indoors or out of doors, that is not carrying on its legs and body bacteria of all kinds and the spores of moulds and other organisms that accompany decay," he replied. "No living fly is free from germs; the spores of moulds and bacteria are everywhere. The microscopic bacteria and other decay-producing organisms, of which it cannot possibly rid itself, will spend more in British Columbia during the next few years than for many years past. The Great Northern will double the track line between Vancouver and New Westminster."

DAIRY FARMING

These Who Attend the Cows Should "Keep Cool"

No branch of agriculture requires the operator to "keep cool" more than dairy farming. No hot-headed individual should be allowed to attend the cows. The attendant to get the best possible flow of milk "keep cool"—that is, must never lose their heads, use loud talk, or be rough. The milk must be kept at a low temperature to be wholesome. Cream must be kept cool. To do this, ice or very cold water is necessary. Cream—must be kept away from the heat. "Keep cool" is always reasonable in dairy work. From the stable to the consumer, everything in connection with the dairy business gives best results when it is kept scrupulously clean at a low temperature.
