HIS VISIT TO THE POPE
A Lutheran Minister's Graphic Description of an Audience
HE ACKNOWLEDGED INFALLIBILITY.
OVERCOME BY AN INEFFABLE SENSE OF THE EXTRAORDINARY IN THE PRESENCE OF THE PRINCE OF CARDINALS.

"The Pope's memory, his faculty to recall remote circumstances, astonished me beyond expression. In the ante-chamber, his small brown eyes shone with a kindly gleam, but as soon as he himself commenced talking these eyes became vivid with the fire of intelligence and ardor. During the time of his discourse he appeared most reverent and soon began demanding seemingly unimportant details, while he furnished dates and incidents of distant subjects pertaining to the cases that were at once surprising and new to me."
