**Public Notice!**  
Mr. Lewis J. Bartlett has been appointed by the Government in place of the late Mr. Eli Whiteway to attend to the movement of patients to and from the various public institutions with headquarters at the Public Health Office, St. John's. Medical Practitioners, Relieving Officers, and others are hereby notified that patients shall on no account be sent to St. John's without first receiving assurance from Mr. Bartlett that they can be admitted or, in the case of the General Hospital, that costs will be available upon their arrival. It has been brought to the notice of the Government that sick people sent on without authority have been caused much additional suffering and hardship in boarding houses in the city, in some cases with risk of permanent injury to their health, for which of course they themselves or their advisors have been responsible. Cases other than emergency cases coming to St. John's without the proper authority will run the risk of being immediately sent back to their homes, so as to prevent undue suffering, as it is impossible to provide accommodation for all applicants under existing conditions.
