France Makes Endeavor To Have U. S. Concessions Cancelled.

By CONSTANTINE BROWN. pecial Cable to The London Advertiser and Chicago Daily News, Copyright, Constantinople, May 12.-Though officials in Angora say that the dismissal of Arthur Chester by John Kennedy, who holds a power of attorney from the directors of the American Ottoman Development Company, does not affect the contracts that have been signed, the writer learns from a reliable source that the Turks are becoming skeptical as to the ultimate issues of the enterprise and are willing to listen to other propositions.

The French are taking full advantage of the dissensions and have despatched to Angora representatives of the Bablia Karaien Railway Company, who are given power to use strong arguments, which are always apt to succeed with Turkish officials of the new regime and induce them to cancel the concession. The French efforts to wreck the Chester projects are due to a desire to have the whole field free to them selves and thus be able to pick what.


