Duties,—Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within hing miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 50 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or siscer.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section alongside his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties.—Must reside six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (indiading the time required to—earn homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres and certain districts. Tries \$3.00 per a cre. Duties.—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$300,00.


