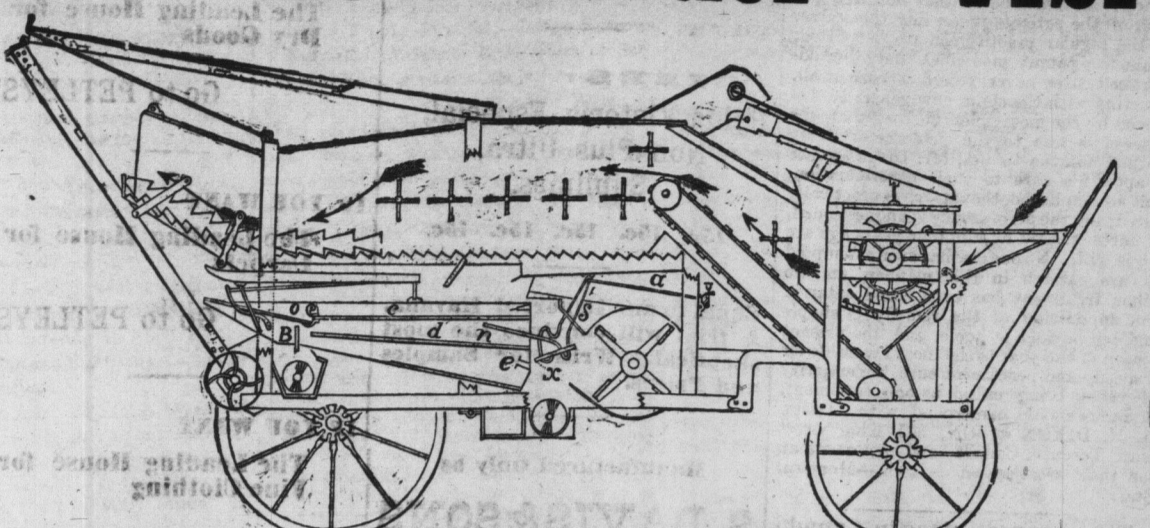

equal to a waste of one bushel in ninety

test has been made in a thorough and sys-
tematic manner. All kinds of grain have
been tested and the result was equally
