The charming city of Victoria, on Vancouver Island, the portal to the Pacific, the ocean gateway to the Orient, is one of the most favored spots in the world in beauty of situation, equability of climate and magnificence of scenery. nificence of scenery. Surrounded by water on three sides, the city is situated in a setting of low-lying wooded hills, in a foreground of the loftier ranges of the Island Cascades. Across the Georgian Straits, the Olympian range is distinctly visible the crowning glory of the scene being Mount Baker, which lifts its dazzling cone in solitary splendor, to a height of 11,000 feet,

Victoria is recognized as possessing one of the finest climates in the world. The winters are very mild and the summers cool. In May and June Victoria is especially enchanting with the gardens of roses, hedges of laurel, bushes of sweet briar. In the stately groves, the air is lader with the pungent odor of the pines.

The city is approached through a channel of wooded islands. On the




