connected with civil and social life, is in the hands of teachers and pupils. Surely a book can be had and prescribed such as will meet the approvat of all classes, and be of great corvice in inducing that habit of moral thoughtfulness to which Dr. Arnold, of Rugby, rightly attached so much importance. A basis for the morality inculcated in such a book, which should, of course, avoid dogmatism on doubtful or difficult questions, could be found in the individual conscience on the one hand, and in such axiomatic principles as the Golden Rule on the other. As such teaching should be entirely prac-Lical, aiming solely at the development of judgment and conscience, no troublesome questions of the origin and nature of the moral faculty need be raised, at least in the elementary schools. The fact of the existence of this faculty with large capacity for culture is all that is needed. But, further, assuming that the teacher in importance: First, whatever system surpassed those of any other people. may ultimately provail, immediate provision should be made, at the sacrifice, if necessary, of some other less ditions, and without which under no conditions, can such moraland religious training be secured. Under any circumstances, the moral and religious character of the schools will be determined by the teachers, and so by the trustees who select the teachers. and so by the parents who elect the
