The schedules of services to be operated by the designated airlines shall where possible be agreed upon between these airlines prior to the submission of such schedules for approval by the aeronautical authorities of the contracting parties. The designated airlines shall prior to the submission of their schedules for approval, consult with each other on the type of aircraft to be used by each airline in the operation of its scheduled services.

C. The provisions of the attached text of the proposed agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of Barbados on international air services, unless otherwise specified in this exchange of notes, shall govern the exercise of the agreed services referred to in A and B.

It is agreed that delegations of our two countries shall meet again at a date to be mutually agreed with a view to reaching a definitive agreement between our two Governments on international air services.

I also have the honour to propose that the Licence issued to the designated airline of Barbados by the Canadian Transport Commission to operate services between Barbados and Montreal shall be subject to the terms of this exchange of notes and to the attached text of the proposed agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of Barbados on international air services and the Conditions annexed thereto.

I have therefore the honour to propose that, if the foregoing is acceptable to your Government, this note, which is authentic in English and in French, and your reply to that effect shall constitute an Interim Agreement between our two Governments on international air services which shall enter into force on the date of your reply and the traffic rights specified above shall be considered as an annex to the proposed agreement.
