University-to-university agreement for students and faculty, especially of the Department of Mathematics. The number of participants is subject to negotiation, but the exchange mainly focuses on the exchange of faculty members. Students participating are usually treated as "special students" (which is a sort of part-time student status).

Precondition for participation is a successful TOEFL Test result. The students are screened and selected by a committee of representatives from the department (mainly Mathematics) and from the "Akademisches Auslandsamt". German students can apply for financial support for up to 50% of the travel expenses.

Credits obtained at the partner university are usually accepted by the home university, provided that the exchange students discussed their choice of courses with lecturers from their home university in advance.

The exchange lasts one academic year.

N.B. The Universität UIm also participates in the Ontario-Baden-Württemberg exchange program. Within the framework of this province-to-province exchange program, about four sturdents from UIm go to universities in Ontario, e.g. the University of Western Ontario.
