To the Honorable the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Canada, in Parliament Assembled:

The Petition of the Municipal Council of the County of Lambton—Respectfully Sheweth:

THAT your petitioners view with dread, applications from the Grand Trunk Railway Company for further aid.

That in the opinion of your petitioners that Company has already had too much assistance from Parliament; and that it is an injustice to foster a Railway Company at the expense of the country.

Your petitioners therefore pray, that no further applications for aid be entertained, from that already over-subsidized Company.

And your petitioners, as in duty bound, will ever pray.
