Chutes—Company will build first section of chutes, miners ^{shall} build thereafter, and ^{shall} will be paid a rate of 30 cents per lineal yard for all chutes built. ^{shall} The Company to deliver all materials to foot of chutes.

Brushing—Six feet wide, 5 cents per inch in depth per lineal yard. Twelve feet wide, 10 cents per inch in depth per lineal yard.
