**Develop a

With the Kodak Film Tank, the amateur can develop a number of rolls of film at once by merely providing himself with extra tanks, aprons, and reels, which will be found listed (Duplicating Outfits) in the price list.

**Outfit Self
Contained.**

The Winding Boxes themselves are strongly made with metal parts nickered. The Tank is of brass, heavily nickered. Both handles of the box are removable, and, together with the tank and apron, can be packed inside of the box, thus making the entire outfit self-contained.
