reality, that we would hail the power of Jesus' name, and such lives are a royal diadem to crown Him Lord of all.

We rejoice with our brother in his precions remnion with the sweet and devoted wife, who entered so heartily into all his labors, shared so much of suffering with him, and who preceded him to the glory land. We rejoice in our brother's coronation, and that he wears for evermore the martyr's crown of life. Farewell, beloved, till the day break and the shadows flee away."
