Whereas, The Bill to consolidate and amend various Acts of Assembly relating to the Church of England, approved at the last meeting of the Synod was, upon its being brought before the Legislature, amended in certain particulars relating firstly to the qualifications at Parish elections, and secondly to the division of Parishes; and

Whereas, The Lord Bishop and the Standing Committee, being of opinion that the second of such amendments affected the principles of a section of the said Bill, thereupon withdrew the same; therefore

Resolved, That the Synod, while approving the action of the Lord Bishop and the Standing Committee, hereby authorizes them to assent to the amendment so made, and further

Resolved, That the Lord Bishop and the Standing Committee of the Diocese be requested to bring the said Bill be-
