The *Mayor's Court* is held at the Court House the first Monday in June, September, December, and March, in each year; the jurisdiction of which extends over the city and liberties, when the Mayor for the time being presides, assisted by one or more of the Aldermen, for the trial of persons committed for petty thefts, assaults and batteries, nuisances against the city, &c. The aldermen of the respective Wards are likewise empowered to act as Magistrates within the Wards by which they are returned. The Mayor is to be chosen by a majority of the Aldermen and Common Council, on the Thursday following the election of the Aldermen, &c., and is to enter on the duties of his office on the first Monday of the following month.

The Aldermen and Common Councilmen hold their offices from the first Monday in February till the day before the first Monday in February of the following year, both days inclusive.
