



## TORONTO SHOULD ADD 5,000 HOUSES YEARLY

I To Be Enough One-Family Homes When Men Return

Among all the preparations Toronto is making for the day when our men come back to us, none is more important, and perhaps less thought of than the homes they are to come back to.
The army has taken the kink out of their backs, bronzed their cheeks, and given them an incurable thirst for fresh air, and it is the big idea of our medi-cal health department that they shall not come back to tenement houses in

"In the next five years," said J. T. Schoales, of the housing division, Public Health department, "Toronto's population will have increased 150,000. It increased by 200,000 in the five years before the war. And with an average of five to a family it will mean that we will have to provide 30,000 more houses. At the very least 5,000 houses should be crected every year for five years, and unless we can get them overcrowding will be rampant; slums will increase, and the community will pay the penalty."

Toronto's fight against slum conditions is trying to be the proverbial stitch in time. 


