## BERLIN OUTBREAK IS SOON QUELLED

**Demonstration Before Imperial Palace and the Police Fire Shots**

Berlin, Nov. 27.—A Communist demonstration which was staged this afternoon in front of the old Imperial Palace, and which was more in the nature of a hunger riot than anything else, ended tonight. A crowd of several thousand, mostly unemployed, assembled in the Lustgarten.

The crowd sang Communist songs, but the police were not called upon to do more than fire shots in the air, whereupon the demonstrators dispersed.

An attempt to erect a barricade in Reiterstrasse, behind the palace, was frustrated by the police. Several assemblies in the suburbs were also easily dispersed by the police using clubs. A few of the demonstrators were injured and 77 of them were placed under arrest.

Germany was still without a chancellor or an effective government at a late hour tonight and the five bourgeois parties, which were supposed to constitute a new coalition bloc, were far from accord which would give them a united front in the Reichstag.

Adam Stegwald, former premier of Prussia and Central leader, is now being groomed for the chancellorship.
