

B. C. STEEL SHIPBUILDING. Vancouver, B. C., Dec. 30.—(Canadian Press)—Steel shipbuilding in British Columbia shows a larger deadweight tonnage of production for 1920 than for the preceding year.

In 1919 steel vessels reached 70,200 deadweight tonnage, while in 1920 the output of British Columbia coast yards was 83,300 steel tons. Included in this year's construction are five freighters for the Canadian Government Merchant Marine, twelve vessels were launched.
