

JAPAN WILL HELP COREA Sir Henry Berkeley Thinks That Hermit Kingdom Will Prosper

Toronto, Oct. 6—In the recent anexation of Corea by Japan, Sir Henry Spencer Berkeley, attorney-general of Hong Kong, who is staying for several days at the King Edward, sees nothing to worry over. He says the annexation is a realization of a legitimate aspiration on Japan's part to extend the borders of her empire.

"The taking over of Corea was the natural consequence of the growth of Japan," said Sir Henry, "and I firmly believe that it will be happy in its results for the Coreans. The Japs are great administration of their laws. I look for a great development in the Hermit Kingdom as the result of its incorporation with Japan. "From the strategic standpoint the acquirement of Corea was essential to the defence of Japan."

"But what about the future—will Japan proceed to annex Manchuria as she did Corea?" was asked.
