

DEPUTATION TO THE W. M. CONFERENCE.

Reference having been made to the fact that the Wesleyan Methodist denomination in Canada were at present holding the annual meeting of their Conference in this City, it was, on motion made by Mr. Morris, seconded by Dr. Urquhart, and carried with acclamation, resolved to appoint a Deputation, consisting of Dr. Cook, Dr. Urquhart, Messrs. Kenneth Maclellan; Alexander Morris, and Croil, to visit that Body, tender to them our fraternal greetings, and wish them God-speed in the great work of evangelizing this land, in which, in common with us, they are engaged.

The Synod adjourned to meet in this place to-morrow morning at a quarter before eleven o'clock, of which public intimation was made, and this Diet was closed with prayer.

DIET IV.
