

The Canadian bill would secure copyholders and authorize the granting copyright protection in Canada to own of copyrights in other parts of the

The provisions will affect all subjects of majesty and bona fide residents in his ajesty's dominions where the article or bject is produced in his majesty's do-ninions. All kinds of copyrights will be couped together and a criminal penalty ause incorporated to protect dramatic and musical productions as well as literary and artistic productions. The protection of the copyright act would extend during he life time of the author and fifty year hereafter.

Mr. Borden asked if the proposed ac stablished Canadian copyright legislation n practically the same lines as that of reat Britain and the other overseas do-

Mr. Fisher replied in the affirmative He also explained that a United States uthor, who resided the greater part of e year in Canada and produced hi orks in this country, would secure the lvantages of the act.
