An Act to authorise the redemption of certain Ground Rents in Lower Canada.

FER MAJESTY by and with the advice and consent of the Legisla- Preamble. tive Council and Assembly of Canada enacts as follows:

I. From and after the passing of this Act it shall not be lawful to No irredeemcreate any perpetual irredeemable ground rent, but all such rents shall able rent to be created here-5 be redeemable at the option of the debtor, and subject to all the pro- after. visions of law respecting constituted rents, (rentes constituées.)

II. Any ground rent created before the passing of this Act may be Ground Rents redeemed by the debtor thereof, at his option, upon payment by him to now existing to be redeemthe creditor of a principal sum, the interest whereof at the rate of six able. 10 per centum per annum, shall be equal to the amount of the said rent.

III. This Act shall apply only to Lower Canada.
