THEREAS it is expedient to provide for the com- Prosmble. mutation of the bonds required in certain cases under the act hereinafter mentioned; Be it therefore enacted, &c.

might otherwise require such bond, such sum of money as the Emigrant Agent at Quebec (under any general instructions he may receive from the Governor), shall 20 have fixed in that behalf, as being just and equitable and sufficient to indemnify the Province or any municipality, village or city, town or county, or charitable institution within the same, against the risk of expense for the care,

support and maintenance of such passenger or passengers 25 during the then next ensuing three years; and the money Application of sum so paid. so paid shall form part of the Emigrant Fund.
