## BILL.

An Act to repeal the Ordinances relative to Winter Roads in Lower Canada, in so far as regards the Districts of Quebec and Gaspé, and part of the District of Three Rivers.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend Preamble. the Ordinances of the Legislature of the late Province of Lower Canada, relative to Winter Roads, so as to exempt from the 5 operation thereof, the District of Quebec, the District of Gaspé and the District of Three Rivers, except that part of the County of Drummond which is within the District of Three Rivers: Be it therefore enacted, &c.

10 And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing Part of the of this Act, so much of the Ordinance of the Ordinances 3 & 4 V. C. 25, Legislature of the late Province of Lower and 4 V.C. 33, Canada, passed in the Session held in the repealed as to third and fourth weeks of Hard M. 15 third and fourth years of Her Majesty's L.C. Reign, intituled, "An Ordinance, to provide " for the improvement, during the Winter " Season, of the Queen's Highways in this " Province, and for other purposes," or of the 20 Ordinance of the said Legislature, passed in the fourth year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Ordinance to amend the laws "relative to Winter Roads," as enacts that no cariole, traine, berline, or other winter 25 vehicle other than the sleighs described in the said Ordinances, shall be used on any of the Queen's highways or public roads in that part of the Province heretofore Lower Canada, shall be, and so much of the said 30 Ordinances is hereby repealed in so far as regards the District of Quebec, the District of Gaspé, and the District of Three Rivers except that part thereof which is within the County of Drummond, in which and in

35 the Districts of Montreal and St. Francis. the said Ordinances shall remain in force.
