similar to that in the Schedule to this Act

annexed, marked A., (which affidavit or affirmation the said Clerks, Judges and Justices of the Peace are respectively hereby authorized to administer,) and upon then and there fyling the said affidavit or affirmation with such Clerk, Judge, or if taken before a Justice of the Peace with such Justice of the Peace (whose duty it shall be to transmit the same forthwith to the Clerk of the Division 10 Court within whose Division the same was so made or taken, to be filed and kept among Warrant to be the papers in the cause,) it shall be lawful for such Clerk, Judge or Justice of the Peace forthwith to issue a warrant under his hand 15 and seal, directed to the Bailiff of the Division Court within which the same was issued, or to any Constable of the District, commanding such Bailiff or Constable to attach, seize, take and safely keep all the 20 personal estate and effects of the absconding. removing or concealed person or persons, of what nature and kind soever, liable to seizure under execution for debt, within such District, or a sufficient portion thereof to 25 secure the sum mentioned in the warrant, with the costs of the action, and to return the same forthwith to the Division Court of the Division wherein such warrant was issued. upon receipt of which warrant the Bailiff or 30 Constable to whom the same may be directed. shall forthwith execute the same, and with the assistance of two freeholders make a just and true inventory of all such personal estate and effects as he shall seize and take 35 by virtue thereof, and shall forthwith return the same to the Clerk of the Division Court in the Division within which such warrant was issued, and which warrant may be in the form of that in the Schedule to this Act annexed, 40 marked B.; Provided always, that the free

holders and appraisers authorized by this

Act shall be entitled to receive for each day they may be employed in carrying its enactments into effect the sum of two shillings and 45 sixpence each, to be paid in the first instance

issued for seizing the property.
