

But we promise to use our best Endeavours to be Mediators to End this War. We expect that you are sincere in your Engagement in Laying down the Hatchet against our Brethren of New England and that the same may be buried in everlasting Oblivion

The Ind^s Inhabiting at St. Francois we Esteem as part of the Eastern Ind^s. We are Concerned that they have not Delegated some of their Sachms to Conclude a Solid & lasting Peace. And as they have Impowerd you to Act as you Judge for the best of you all We expect you'll Encourage those Ind^s to Come to Terms of Peace to end this War

The Hostages now at Boston we can't perceive how our Brethren of New England should sell them at Liberty till the peace be actually Concluded And its surprizing to us that Gov. Vaudrill should Encourage the Ind^s in that Demand & sending an Inhand by you & giving ^{Words of} his honour that if the Hostages were delivered he would command the Eastern Ind^s to be at Peace & lay down the Hatchett

It Concerns us that while you came on purpose to lay down the hatchet of that treacherous felon Schononda wth six other Ind^s went out from Cackawaga to fight toward New England and has since as we are Informed Comitted fresh hostilities We expect you'll show your utmost Repentment of this base Act, and that at your Return home you'll take the prisoners out of their hands w^{ch} we shall account as a sincerity of the performance of part of the Engagement you lately made

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We return you thanks that before your Departure from Montreal you dispatched a Sachim of Shawonadie to prevent the Quebeck Ind^s from going a fighting against our Brethren of New England

We think it necessary to acct you that several Negro slaves have of late Run from hence to Canada, and that others have lately been enticed by some of your men now here to run thither, and we desire you to discourage you People from such pernicious practices, for Inticing them from us is the same as robbing us of our goods and may be a motive to make a Breach in the good Agreement & Correspondence hitherto maintaind between us

The Sachms answerd that we shall discourage our young Men ~~rather~~ ~~rather~~ from debauching or Enticing Negro Slaves to Run to Canada that Schononda with his party went a fighting ag^t their Order and Resolution of all the Sachms
Then the Com^{rs} said

It's pleasing to us that this Conference ends so Amicably & hope it may have the same Effect wth the Boston Com^{rs} the Sachms of the five Nations & yo^r several tribes now here Then they gave four Shots in Confirmation of what has been transacted at this Meeting
