look larger when seen through the eyes of others than when the consciousness of one's own limitations presses in upon one, as it must inevitably do in any subjective estimate.

I believe, with you, that our legislation is worthy of consideration by your Government. It has been of great service in this country, and where, as with you, the need, as well as the opportunities are so much greater. I should think that similar measures might be of the greatest possible service.
