FROM
THE TORONTO WOMEN'S LIBERAL ASSOCIATION
PRESENTED
AUGUST 14, 1920

WHEREAS during the past years there have occurred within the ranks of the Liberal Party differences in interpretation of the principles of Liberalism;

AND WHEREAS the principles of Liberalism are based upon freedom of thought and action;

AND WHEREAS whatever differences have arisen in the past few years have now entirely disappeared within the minds and hearts of the men and women to whom Liberal principles are dear, and, in the opinion of this Association a great wave of re-united Liberal effort is the dominant political factor in Canada to-day;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. This Association do express unbounded confidence in the integrity, ability and lofty purpose of the Honorable William Lyon Mackenzie King, our present Liberal Leader, and the principles of Liberalism as interpreted by the platform defined at the Liberal Convention of August 1919.
